



Railway. This was all taken over by GWR in 1880. This section of railway from Ebbw Vale to Beaufort may have been little used but the lower section was of major importance for Ebbw Vale Steelworks further down the valley and has now been reopened for passenger services.

opposite the “Glan yr Afon” sheltered housing complex, you will find a small circular Great Western Railway marker dated 1900 stuck into the bank as a testament to the line having been taken over by the GWR.

At ‘Shop Row’ you meet a small roundabout where the Beaufort Ironworks Company Shop lay on the left. The road that crosses through the roundabout from left to right (Beaufort Ter1
